NSPCC Data 2011

The majority of victims were girls

14 and 15 year olds are most likely to be noticed by authorities

Some victims of sexual exploitation were as young as 9 or 10 years old

The majority of victims were white

Over **2,400 children** were victims of sexual exploitation in gangs and groups from August 2010 to October 2011
