Dear Parent and Carers,

It has been wonderful to welcome all of our students back this week. They have approached their return with maturity and I have been so impressed with our new Year 7s, who really have made a great first impression and have received lots of House Points so far. Keep it up!

Next week will be the first full week for us all. Students **cannot** access the school site until 8.25am when the pedestrian gate will be open. Students will be able to get a free breakfast from 8.30am until 8.45am. Please do get your child to ensure they time their journey to school keeping this in mind as we all need to be respectful of the wider community, avoiding large congregations.

We're incredibly proud of the standards our school upholds and always feel a great sense of pride when visitors comment on the impeccable appearance of our children. Can we remind parents:

- Please ensure your child has a suitable coat. Hoodies and hooded jumpers are not classed as coats and are not permitted in school
- Skirts should be loose fitting and worn to the knee; similarly, trousers should be loose fitting – leggings/jeggings are not allowed in school
- No trainers are to be worn in the school building
- Only plain headbands, which are serving a purpose, are allowed in school. Flowered headbands and bandanas are not to be worn.
- If students choose to bring mobile phones and/or airpods into school, they must be switched off and out of sight at all times
- On the grounds of safety, only one watch and one small ring are allowed. Only one pair of small earrings (studs only) is allowed, that is one earring per ear. No facial piercing whatsoever are allowed.

Please also remember that the wearing of face coverings in school is voluntary. However, should students choose to wear one, it must cover their nose and mouth when in public spaces.

Students should arrive in their school uniform every day and only bring their PE kit with them on the days they have PE. Only the school PE kit is allowed – no branded tracksuits or t-shirts. We're delighted that the All Weather Pitch is operational again at lunchtimes. A rota will be advertised but students must bring the appropriate Astro turf trainers with a dimpled sole if they want to use the AWP.

As always, can we thank all of our parents and carers for the continued support you offer to our school. It is a privilege to work with your children.
