Dear Parent and Carers,



We write to wish you and your family a lovely summer break and to keep you up to date with expectations when Year 7s start on Wednesday 6 September and all other year groups on Thursday 7 September.

We continue to offer a free breakfast and our Welcome Window opens from 8:30am. The Welcome Window provides an opportunity for students to check in with a Pastoral Leader if they need any assistance throughout the day. We encourage our students to be on site at 8.40am to ensure our learning day can start promptly.

If your child is unwell and unable to attend please contact school by 8.30am on 0121 566 4300 and select option 1, there is an answerphone on this line and you can leave details of your child's absence so that we can check that all students expected have arrived safely to school.

Students should arrive in their school uniform every day bringing their PE kit with them on the days they have PE. Only the school PE kit is allowed – no branded tracksuits or t-shirts. Students should also arrive at school fully equipped to learn, and this should include a scientific calculator.

When buying new uniform please use the information below as a guide to support you in ensuring students are dressed professionally as we encourage them to take pride in their appearance:

- Hoodies and hooded jumpers are not classed as coats and are not permitted in school
- Skirts should be loose fitting and worn to the knee; similarly, trousers should be loose fitting – leggings/jeggings are not allowed in school
- School shoes should be able to be polished, trainers are not permitted
- Only plain headbands, which are serving a purpose, are allowed in school. Flowered headbands and bandanas are not to be worn
- On the grounds of safety, only one watch and one small ring are allowed. Only one pair of small earrings (studs only) are allowed, that is one earring per ear. Only clear nose studs are permitted.

As you are undoubtedly aware, if students choose to bring mobile phones and/or headphones into school, they must be switched off and out of sight at all times. If students are seen with these items, they will be confiscated even if they are checking their timetable.

Students are given multiple copies of their paper timetable over the year which they must keep in their pocket and use to make sure they arrive to lessons on time.
