Did you know that as well as free school meals during term time, you are also entitled to access FREE holiday clubs during spring, summer and winter holidays?

Bring it on Brum! is a FREE Holiday Activity and Food Programme funded by the Department for Education, designed for children and young people across Birmingham to have healthy, active, fun-filled school holidays. Bring it on Brum! believe that everyone deserves a good break and that school holidays are better when children and young people are active, having fun, being entertained and learning new things.

If your child is aged between 4-16 and is eligible for benefits-related free school meals, then they are entitled to access the Bring it on Brum! holiday clubs for free! There are a huge range of activities available including sports and games, arts and crafts, cookery, dance and music. Programmes vary depending on the type and location of each local club and each holiday club will give your child a nutritious meal too!

We hope you will take advantage of these fantastic FREE holiday clubs across Birmingham so your child/children can have a fun-filled and safe holiday!

The winter holiday clubs will take place from Monday 23rd December– Friday 3rd January. Excludes Bank Holidays and weekends. Bookings open on Monday 2nd December.

To complement the wide range of Bring it on Brum! holiday clubs, families of children aged 4-16 who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals can apply to receive a Food Box and/or Activity Pack.

Activity Packs

There are two types of activity packs available, one for primary-aged children and another for secondary-aged children. Each activity pack contains fun arts and crafts projects, games and activities that can be completed throughout the holidays.

Families can apply for a maximum of one activity pack per eligible child. You will need to enter the details for each eligible child to request activity packs. There are two types of activity packs available depending on your child’s age, secondary or primary.

Food Boxes
